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# HIGHER SECONDARY EXAMINATION RESULTS

MARCH 2014

## GENERAL INFORMATION

**342410** candidates appeared for the Higher Secondary Examination, March 2014 from **1873** schools and **271836** became eligible for higher studies (EHS), the percentage of results for this year being **79.39**, last year the percentage was 81.34. The department congratulates the **6783** students who got A+ in all subjects.

Result statistics reveal that of the **180611** girls who took the exam, **154611 (85.60%)** became eligible for higher studies while from among the **163736** boys **118687 (72.48%)** qualified for higher studies. The statistics for the various streams show that in the science stream **134202 (79%)** candidates qualified for higher studies from the **169884** who took the exam, while in the humanities stream it is **53933 (75.68%)** candidates out of **71265**. And in the commerce stream **83701 (82.66%)** candidates qualified for higher studies among the **101261** candidates who appeared for the exam.

In the sector wise results the Aided sector tops with **82%** (out of **155901** candidates **127843** qualified for higher studies) followed by the Government sector **78.77%** (**120899** candidates out of **153491** became eligible for higher studies). In the unaided sector the percentage of E.H.S is **69.75** (**22875** candidates qualified for higher studies out of **32796**).

Eligibility for higher studies is D+ or above grade for all subjects with 30% scores in theory alone and an aggregate total of 30% in theory, practical evaluation and continuous evaluation taken together.

Double valuation was done for the answer scripts of Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics and the tabulations of scores of these subjects was done online. In the case of all other subjects tabulation was done in the Computer lab at the Directorate.

Among the districts **Ernakulam** District with a percentage of **84.35** tops the list while **Pathanamthitta** is the district with the lowest percentage ie. **71.73%**. **Ernakulam** District tops the list with **757** candidates scoring A+ grade in all subjects.

Among the schools **St. Mary's HSS Pattom** presented the highest number of candidates for the exam ie. **758** and came out with a pass percentage of **91.69** followed by **SVHSS Palemaed (697 candidates 88.36%)** and **Govt. Rajah's HSS Kottakkal, Malappuram (636 Candidates 85.91%)**

### **TECHNICAL STREAM**

The Technical Stream of the Higher Secondary Course is run by Technical Schools. In the Technical Stream **1873** candidates took the Higher Secondary Examination, March 2014 from **25** technical schools. **1401** Candidates became eligible for higher studies, the pass percentage being **74.80** Last year it was **80.97%**.

### **ART STREAM**

The Art Stream is conducted in the Kalamandalam Art School. This year **64** students appeared for the Higher Secondary Examination and **61** qualified for higher studies. The pass percentage is **95.31**.

### **OPEN SCHOOL**

**65758** candidates appeared for the Higher Secondary Examination, March 2014 in various streams through Open School and **24654** qualified for higher studies. The percentage of results is **37.49** Last year it was 35.13.

### **COMPARTMENTAL CANDIDATES**

Candidates who failed to become eligible for Higher Studies in the Higher Secondary Examinations of March 2007, 2008 and 2009 appeared for the Examination in March 2014 as Scheme II candidates. Out of **929** students in this category, **479** Students qualified for higher studies (**51.56%**).

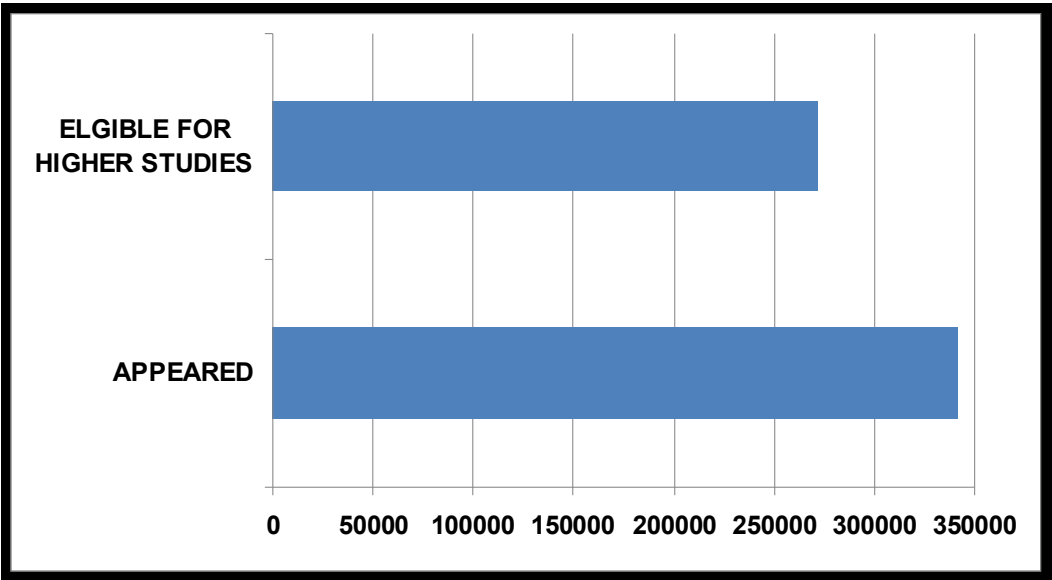
Scheme I candidates of March 2010, 2011, 2012 and 2013 Higher Secondary Examinations who failed to attain D+ or above grades for all subjects and who had attended the First Year Higher Secondary Improvement Examination in September 2013 also registered for March 2014 Examination as Compartmental candidates under Scheme I. Out of **24080** students in this category, **6747** students qualified for higher studies (**28.02%**).

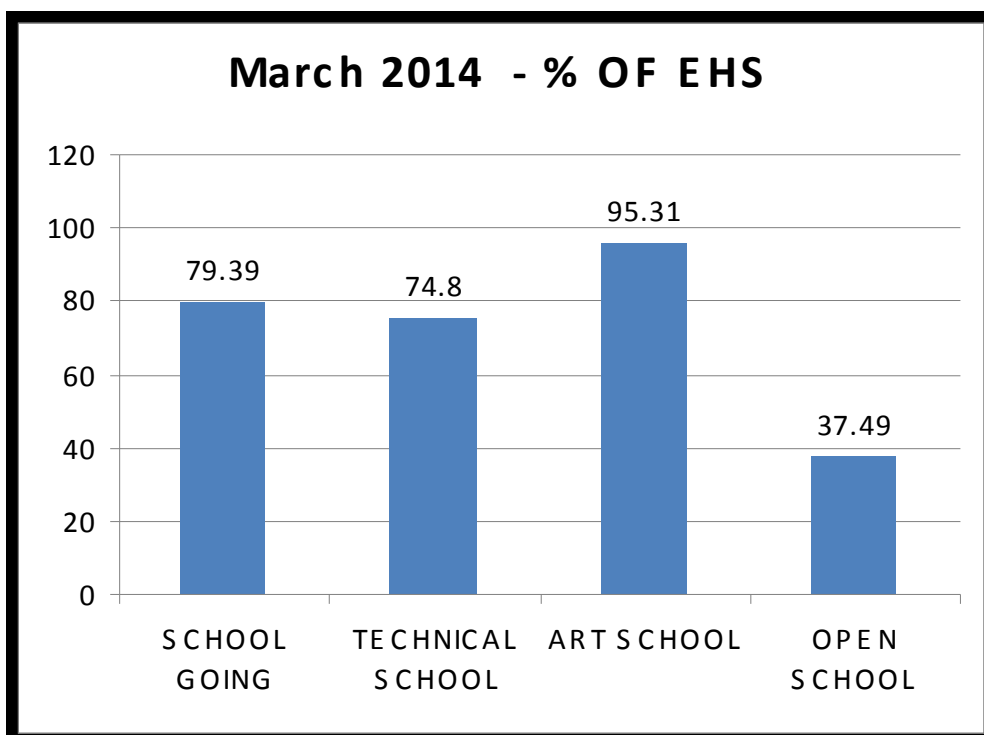

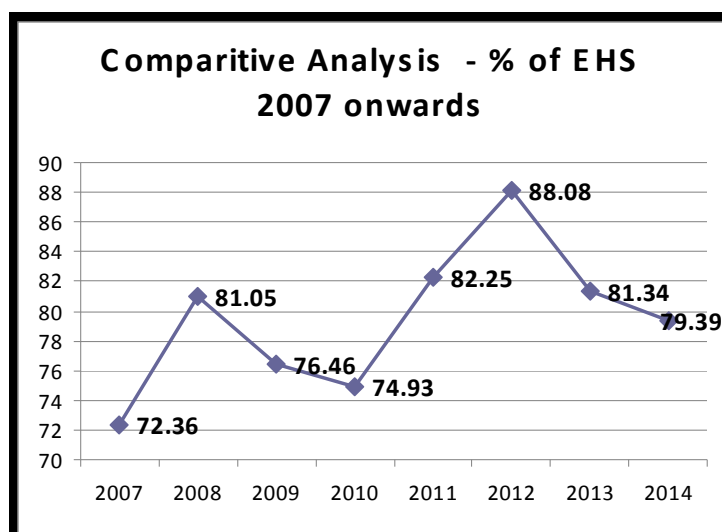
